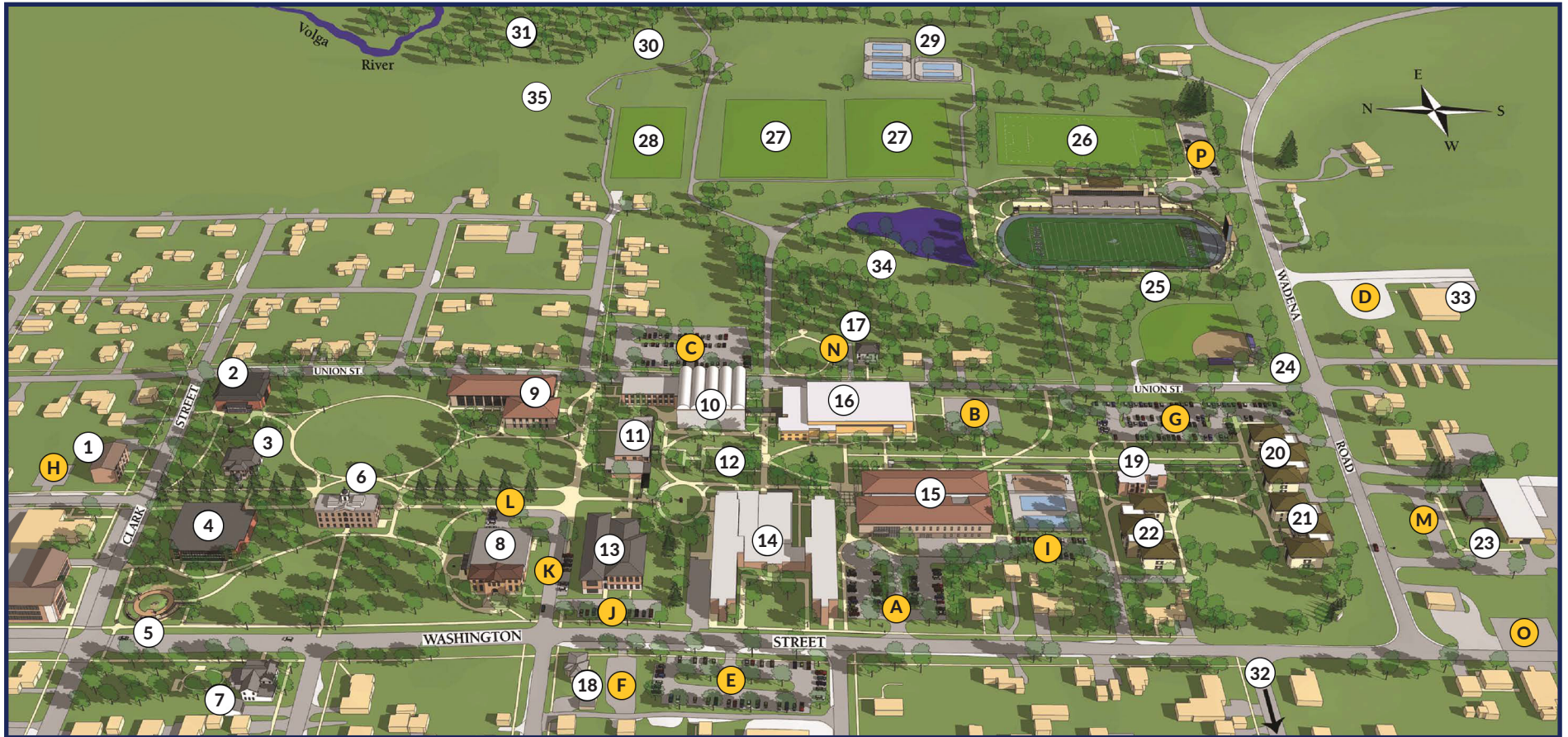

**Mike Arduser:** Mike has studied native bees for over 30 years and taught courses on native bees for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, The Nature Conservancy, and others. Mike is a retired natural history biologist with the Missouri Department of Conservation.
